Attention Conference Officers

Per Board Resolution 46, the Council Director of Finance is added to all Conference Chase Bank accounts as both a signer and authorized representative to serve as the main point of contact with the conferences on their banking needs.

All new account requests, additions/deletions of signers, or requests for online access should be submitted to the Director of Finance. The Director of Finance will confirm that any new signers are listed in the SVdP National Database and are current with CMG: Safe Haven training as per the Archdiocese's Safe Environment policy.

Once compliance is confirmed, a request is made to send a secure email to initiate the process.

All new bank accounts are opened with the Council Office address; the mailing address is changed to the address of the Conference after the account has been established with activity.


Central Texas Flood Relief


